CITY OF RAINBOW CITY- COUNCIL MEETING-DECEMBER 9, 2024

The City Council of the City of Rainbow City, Alabama, met in regular session at City Hall at 5:00 p.m. The invocation was given by Jeff Prince. Mayor Taylor led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Taylor, and upon roll call by City Clerk, Beth Lee, the following members answered present: Anita Bedwell, Randy Vice, Jeff Prince, Jameson Jenkins, Clark Hopper, and Mayor Taylor. The same constituting a quorum of the City Council, the following business was transacted.

- 1. Mayor Taylor presented the minutes of the regular Council meeting of November 25, 2024 and asked if there were any corrections, additions, or deletions. There being none, Jeff Prince made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Randy Vice seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
- 2. Mayor Taylor stated that no bids were received for the surplus items in Administration and that the items will be disposed.
- 3. Mayor Taylor recognized Harold Jennings from Oneonta and Frank Thomas from Altoona who are members of the Rainbow City Coin Club. They presented checks for \$1,000 for the Rainbow City Library, \$1,500 for Rainbow Middle School, \$1,500 for John S. Jones Elementary School, and \$1,500 for Toys Under the Rainbow.
- 4. Mayor Taylor presented the following personnel changes:
 - Accept the retirement of Police Officer, John Bryant, effective January 31, 2025.
 - Post for a full-time Animal Control Officer for ten (10) days to end on Friday,
 December 20, 2024.
 - Post for three (3) firefighter positions to end on Friday, January 17, 2025.

Anita Bedwell made a motion to accept these personnel changes. Jameson Jenkins seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.

5. Jeff Prince made a motion for a one-time pay increase in the amount of \$150.00 for full-time employees and \$100.00 for part-time employees to be paid on December 20, 2024. Randy Vice seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor asked for a roll call as follows:
