CITY OF RAINBOW CITY-COUNCIL MEETING-NOVEMBER 26, 2018

The City Council of the City of Rainbow City, Alabama, met in regular session at City Hall at 5:00 p.m., and upon roll call by City Clerk, Beth Lee, the following members answered present: Mayor Terry John Calhoun, Anita Bedwell, Bobby McCartney, Larry Keenum, and Rick Hill. The same constituting a quorum of the City Council, the following business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Calhoun. Invocation was given by Bobby McCartney. Mayor Calhoun led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

1. Mayor Calhoun presented the minutes of regular and Special Council Meetings- Part 1 & Part 2 of November 13, 2018 for review, and asked if there were any corrections, additions, or deletions. There being none, Rick Hill made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Larry Keenum seconded the motion. Mayor Calhoun stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Calhoun declared the motion carried.

2. Mayor Calhoun announced that there was a vacancy on the Council and stated that interviews had been completed and had great candidates to interview. Rick Hill moved to appoint Rodney Prickett to Place 3. Anita Bedwell seconded the motion. Mayor Calhoun asked the clerk to call the roll as follows:

4. Mayor Calhoun read a recommendation from Fire Chief Melvin Potter to state that Taylor Clough has completed his six (6) month probationary period and increase his pay to \$13.50/hr. Anita Bedwell moved and Rick Hill seconded the motion. Mayor Calhoun stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Calhoun declared the motion carried.

- Salaries (Acct. 01-480-100) - \$10,000.00. Increase – Capital Outlay (Acct. 01-480-400) - \$30,000.00. Rick Hill stated that Michael Stevens's truck will be transferred to Administration once the new truck is delivered and Administration will transfer \$9,531.00 to the Street Dept. budget which is the Kelly Blue Book quote. Anita Bedwell moved and Rick Hill seconded the motion for the revisions. Mayor Calhoun stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Calhoun declared the motion carried.
7. Mayor Calhoun presented a request to surplus one (1) Magic Chef Refrigerator in the Street Dept. and open bids in pre-council on December 10, 2018 at 4:30 p.m. Anita Bedwell moved and Larry Keenum seconded the motion. Mayor Calhoun stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Calhoun declared the motion carried.
 8. Rick Hill welcomed Rodney Prickett to the Council and made a motion to purchase him an iPad and set up a city email address. Larry Keenum seconded the motion. Mayor Calhoun stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Calhoun declared the motion carried.
 9. Mayor Calhoun read the following announcements:

 - Public Safety Banquet will be held Thursday, December 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Center.
